I understand that pursuant to RCW 29A.08.720, any data, lists, or information provided shall only be used for political purposes and shall not be used for commercial purposes. As such, the data, lists, or information provided shall not be used for the purpose of mailing or delivering any advertisement or offer for any property, establishment, organization, product, or service for the purpose of mailing or delivering any solicitation for money, services, or anything of value.

I further understand that any person who violates RCW 29A.08.720, or 29A.08.740 relating to the use of lists of registered voters shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in a state correction facility for a period of not more than five years or a fine of not more than five thousand dollars or both such fine and imprisonment and liable for damages as defined in RCW 29A.08.740.
