## Accessible Voting



Douglas County voters with disabilities have the option of casting their ballot independently using an Accessible Voting Unit (AVU).

AVU's are available in the Auditor's Office starting 18 days before Election Day, until 8 p.m. on Election Day. AVU's are wheelchair accessible, screened from other voters to maintain privacy, and can be outfitted with headphones or sip and puff tools.

## Returning Your Ballot

### Use a Drop Box!

Drop boxes are the best way to ensure your ballot will get to us on time! Drop boxes are securely locked and emptied by teams of two trained Election officials.

Boxes are open 24/7 beginning no less than 18 days before the Election and closed promptly at 8 p.m. on Election night.

Drop boxes are the most direct and secure way to return ballots!

Use VoteWA to:

- Register to vote
- Check or update your voter registration information
- View a list of your elected officials
- Contact your county elections office
- View your online voter guide
- Fill out or print a replacement ballot
- Find an official ballot drop box
- Check the status of your ballot

VoteWA is a collaboration between the Office of Secretary of State and all 39 Washington counties to create an advanced, centralized system for both voter registration and election management.

### **Your Signature Matters!**

- Remember to sign and date the declaration on the return envelope with your name printed on it.
- We compare the signature on your ballot envelope with the signature on your voter registration. This is how we know the ballot comes from you.
- How do we get your signature? If you register or update using a paper registration form, we capture the signature on the form. If you register or update through the Department of Motor Vehicles, we capture the signature from your Washington State Driver License.

### **TOP 4 REASONS A BALLOT CANNOT BE COUNTED**

- Ballot received with a late postmark.
- Signature on the ballot envelope doesn't match the signature we have on file.\*
- Ballot envelope is not signed.\*
- Someone other than the voter has signed the envelope for them.\*

\*If a ballot is not signed or the signature doesn't match the signature on your voter registration, the voter is mailed a form to correct the issue.

## Registering to Vote

### **You can register to vote through Election Day!**

You can now register to vote, update your address, or make other updates to your voter registration in person at Douglas County Courthouse in Waterville through 8 p.m. on Election Day. But why wait. Register or update your registration at [www.votewa.gov](http://www.votewa.gov).

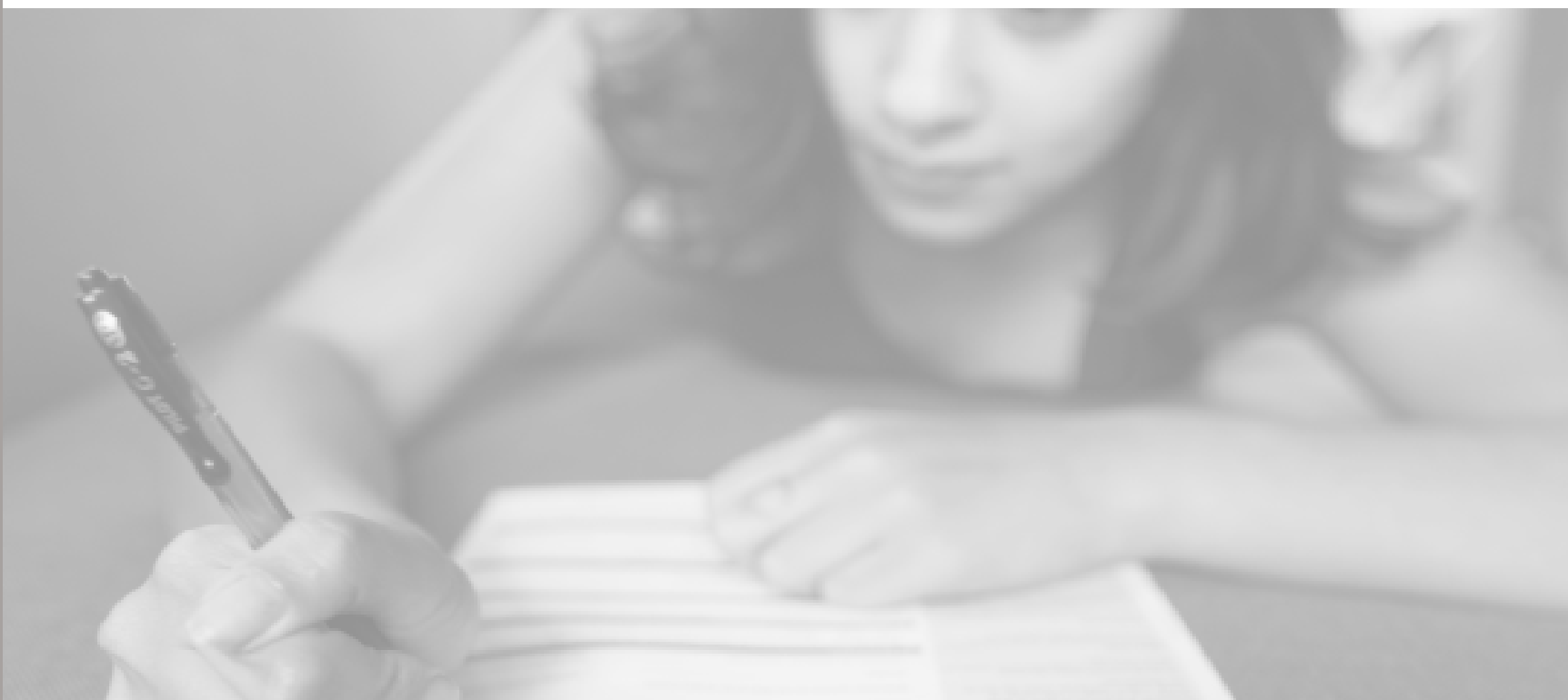
### **Registering to vote through the Department of Licensing or Health Benefit Exchange just got easier!**

If you are getting an enhanced driver license, you will now be automatically registered to vote or have your address updated. Don't wish to register? You can opt out. If you are getting a non-enhanced license, you will still be asked if you would like to register to vote. You can now register to vote while signing up for or renewing your health insurance through the Health Benefit Exchange.

### **Pre-registration for teens**

16 and 17 year olds may now pre-register to vote. Registrations submitted online, by mail, or in person will be assigned a 'pending' status until they turn 18.

If the registrant turns 18 before the next scheduled Election Day, they will automatically be mailed a ballot at their registered address.



## Who Can Register

To register to vote in Washington, you must be:

- A citizen of the United States;
- A legal resident of Washington State;
- At least 18 years old by Election Day;
- Not disqualified from voting due to a court order; and
- Not under Department of Corrections supervision for a Washington State felony conviction.



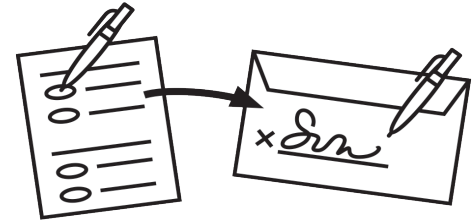
## Keep Your Voter Registration Current

Update your registration if you have moved or changed your name, or if your signature has changed. Simply update your information online or submit a new registration form by October 25 for the General Election or visit us in person through November 2, Election Day.

### Your Voting Rights and Responsibilities:

#### **You have the right to:**

- A replacement ballot
- Accessible voting materials
- Assistance when casting a ballot



#### **You are responsible for:**

- Registering by the deadline
- Updating your residential and/or mailing address
- Returning your ballot by 8 p.m. on Election Day to an official ballot drop box or postmarked by Election Day.

#### **Military or Overseas Voters:**

Maintain your voter registration while in the military or living outside the United States. To register, use your home of record (or that of a family member). You may receive your ballot by mail, email, or fax. Contact us for more information.

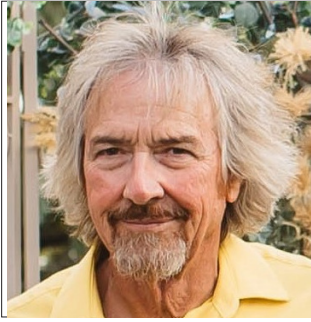
**\*\*No postage needed when mailing your ballot.**

United States Post Office recommends mailing your ballot one week prior to Election Day.



Did you know:

- We offer an online version of the voters' pamphlet at [www.voteWA.gov](http://www.voteWA.gov)
- We have drop boxes in all Douglas County towns.
- There is secure transport for all ballots coming from a drop box to the Douglas County Courthouse in Waterville.
- Washington State is a non-partisan state. You do not have to pick a party when you register.
- The drop box on 2<sup>nd</sup> St. in East Wenatchee is still being used even though the Law and Justice building has moved.
- Washington State has been a vote by mail state since 2011.
- [Votewa.gov](http://Votewa.gov) provides voters with the ability to check registration, check voting history, see a voter's pamphlet, and more.
- All ballots are handled by teams of two. Ballot officials are never alone with a ballot.
- Election workers receive signature training from WA State Patrol.
- You are not required to vote for every race and measure. Your vote will be counted for the races and measures you do vote on.

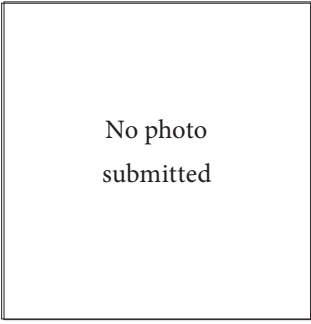

The Douglas County Hospital District No. 2 (Ambulance Services) Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution #83 on July 20, 2021, containing a proposition to finance maintenance and operation. This proposition would authorize the District to levy excess taxes upon all taxable property within the District in the sum of \$70,000, requiring collection of approximately \$0.36 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation in 2022.

Douglas County Hospital District #2 (Ambulance Services) is placing a one-year excess maintenance and operations levy on the November 2021 General Election ballot.

The Hospital District provides medical services to Waterville residents including a clinic, which is contracted with Wenatchee Valley Medical Center, and its own ambulance services. This proposed levy is the same as last year's. If approved, this proposition will authorize the District to raise \$70,000, which is approximately \$.36 per \$1,000 of assessed value on all taxable property within the District in 2022.

## Argument For

The 1-year excess levy for \$50,000.00 or \$.27 per \$1000.00 of assessed property in Douglas County Cemetery District #2 coverage area is needed to maintain adequate irrigation to the Waterville Cemetery and the Gates of Heaven- Catholic Cemetery. Without these additional funds irrigation to these Cemeteries would need to be halted in June 2022. Douglas County Cemetery District #2 pays an average of \$15,000- \$20,000.00 per year just for irrigation water. Douglas County Cemetery District #2 also maintains outlying Cemeteries including- Saint Paul Lutheran (Douglas) Cemetery, Happy Home (Farmer) Cemetery, Badger Mountain View Cemetery, Kummer Cemetery, and Fletcher Cemetery. Without these additional funds maintenance would need to be halted at these cemeteries. A YES vote on this ballot measure would also do the following- keep our service fees low and affordable, enable irrigation repair and upgrades, ensure proper equipment maintenance, availability of the Cemetery for Friday and Saturday Services and also Memorial Day Services. ## Explanatory Statement

Prepared by Steve D. Smith, Attorney at Law

The Waterville Mosquito Control District (the "District") shares the same boundaries as the corporate limits of the Town of Waterville. The purpose of the District is to control mosquitos to a manageable level during the spring mosquito season. The costs of control include mosquito control agents and application labor. RCW 17.28.252 authorizes the District to levy taxes when authorized to do so by the electors of the District by a three-fifths majority of those voting. The Board of Trustees of the District approved Resolution 2021-01 authorizing the levy of a one-year general property tax in the amount of \$0.25 per \$1000 of assessed value for collection in 2022. The District estimates the measure will raise approximately \$23,500 in revenue. The revenue will be used to fund mosquito control efforts for an anticipated period of five years or more.

## Argument For

The Town of Waterville typically has a mosquito problem each spring. Mosquito infestations are detrimental to the health, safety and welfare of the public. The Waterville Mosquito Control District was formed in 2010 to create an entity that would have the authority to raise revenue and pay expenditures specifically related to mosquito control. The voters within the District previously approved a tax levy to raise revenue. The funds were used to purchase a control agent (Anvil 2+2 ULV), equipment to apply the control agent, and the expenses related to application. The prior tax levy proceeds lasted approximately eight years. The proposed new tax levy should last even longer since the application equipment has now been acquired. A vote for the levy is a vote for the efficient control of mosquitoes within the Town.
