**RESOLUTION #1-2021/22
ENRICHMENT LEVY**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE COULEE-HARTLINE SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 151, GRANT AND DOUGLAS COUNTIES, WASHINGTON FOR THE PURPOSE OF SETTING THE DATE OF A SPECIAL LEVY ELECTION AND ASKING QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE DISTRICT WHETHER EXCESS PROPERTY TAXES SHOULD BE LEVIED TO PAY A PORTION OF THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OR ENRICHMENT EXPENSES OF THE DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO;

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.52.053, the Coulee-Hartline School District, Grant and Douglas Counties, Washington (the "District"), may authorize a two-year excess levy for maintenance and operation or enrichment purposes when authorized to do so by a simple majority of the qualified electors of the District, and

WHEREAS, the money in and to be paid to the General fund of the district during the 2022-23, 2023-24, and 2024-25 school years will be insufficient to enable the District to meet all of its maintenance and operation / enrichment needs, and

WHEREAS, in order to provide properly for such maintenance and operation / enrichment needs, it is deemed necessary that an excess tax of approximately \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation to provide an aggregate amount of \$ 350,624 be levied in 2022 as part of the tax to be collected in 2023, and that an excess tax of approximately \$ 1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation to provide an aggregate amount of \$ 350,624 be levied in 2023 as part of the tax to be collected in 2024 said excess taxes being for the District's General fund to pay part of the District's maintenance and operating / enrichment expenses;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of Coulee-Hartline School District No. 151, Grant and Douglas Counties, State of Washington:

- 1. That a special election shall be held in the aforesaid school district on the 8th day of February, 2022 for the purpose of submitting to the electors of said school district, for their approval or rejection, the question of whether or not a special excess tax of \$ 350,624 for collection in 2023, at an estimated \$ 1.50 per one-thousand dollars of assessed valuation, and a special excess tax of \$ 350,624 for collection in 2024, at an estimated \$ 1.50 per one-thousand dollars of assessed valuation.
- 2. That an emergency exists due to the district's needs to provide for its maintenance and operation / enrichment as described above, which emergency requires the ratification or rejection at a special election to be held February 8, 2022 of the proposition of whether or not the District shall levy said excess property taxes.
- 3. That the ballot title of the aforesaid proposition shall be as follows:

Coulee-Hartline School District No. 151

Replacement Maintenance and Operation / Enrichment Levy

The Board of Directors of Coulee-Hartline School District No. 151 adopted Resolution No. 1-2021-22, concerning a proposition to finance maintenance and operation / enrichment expenses. This proposition would authorize the district to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, upon all taxable property within the district, for support of the district's General Fund educational maintenance and operation / enrichment expenses:

That the Clerk of the aforesaid school district is hereby directed to immediately transmit to the Grant County Auditor a copy of this resolution, duly signed and attested, by which the Grant County Auditor is hereby requested to (a) close registrations; (b) request the Auditor of Douglas County to close registrations; and (c) to take all procedural steps necessary and/or required by law to the end that the terms of this resolution shall be submitted to the voters of said school district.
